We are writing today to spread the good news about an exciting mission resource - Living Waters for the World.



Living Waters for the World (LWW) trains and equips church mission teams to deliver the gift of clean, sustainable water to communities in need. LWW does not drill wells; rather we clean available, contaminated water via community-sized water treatment systems that are simple to build, operate and maintain.



This project of the Synod of Living Waters, PC(USA) began in 1993 as a small initiative conducted by a dedicated group of volunteers. In 2004, taking all that we had learned over a ten-year period, we began training and equipping church mission teams to do this work.



The result? As of summer 2006, there are now 82 LWW water treatment systems at sites in Mexico, Guatemala, Brazil, Honduras, Haiti, Belize, Nicaragua, El Salvador, India, Ghana, Philippines, Dominican Republic and the United States. 67 of those systems have been installed by our partners in just the past two and a half years. Expansion into other countries, including Kenya, the Congo and Madagascar, is anticipated in the coming year.



We invite you to learn more about Living Waters for the World. We stand ready to serve as a resource to your mission efforts by training and equipping church mission teams to deliver clean water and related health & hygiene education, working with in-country partners in areas with available, contaminated water.
